



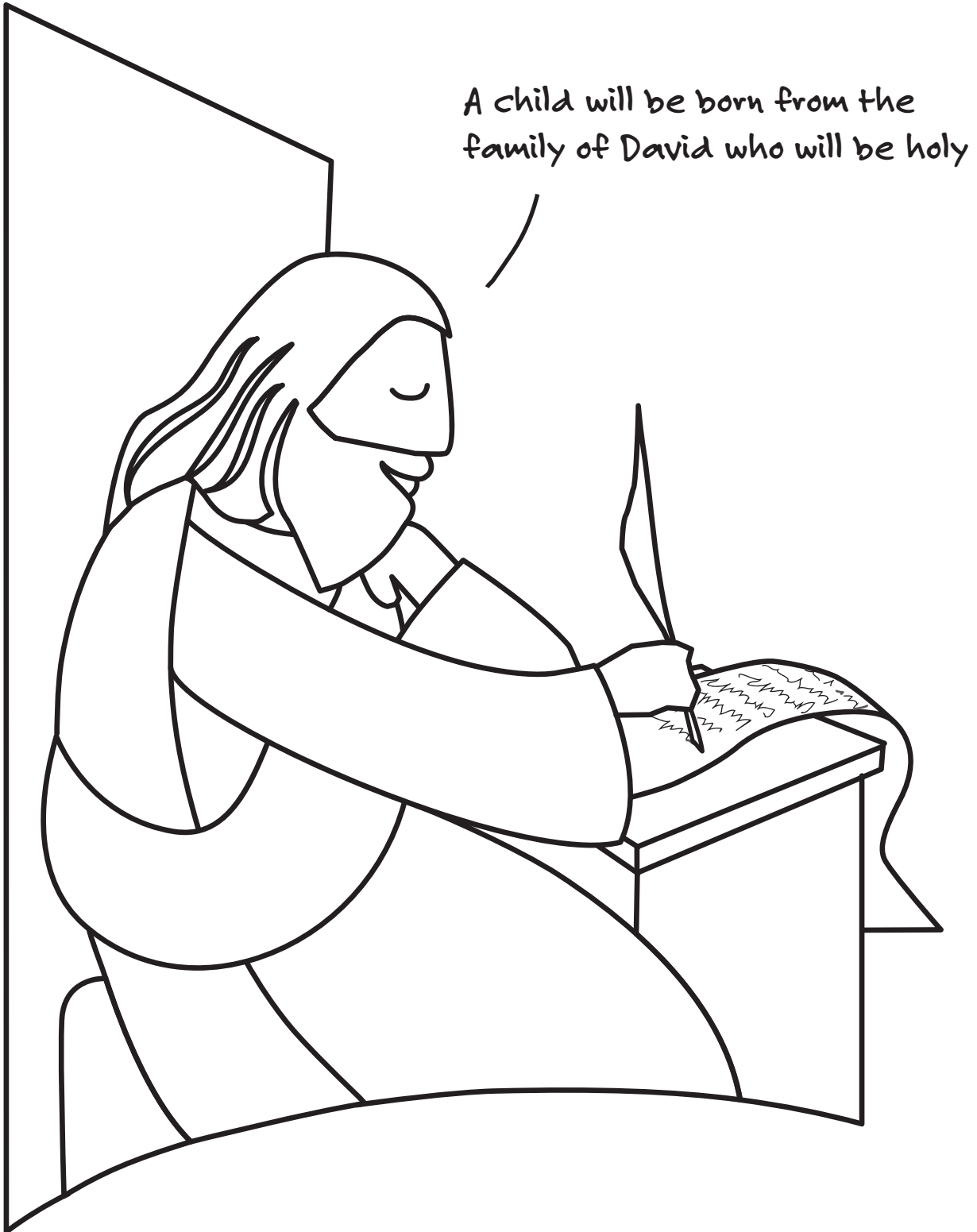

Luke 1:14

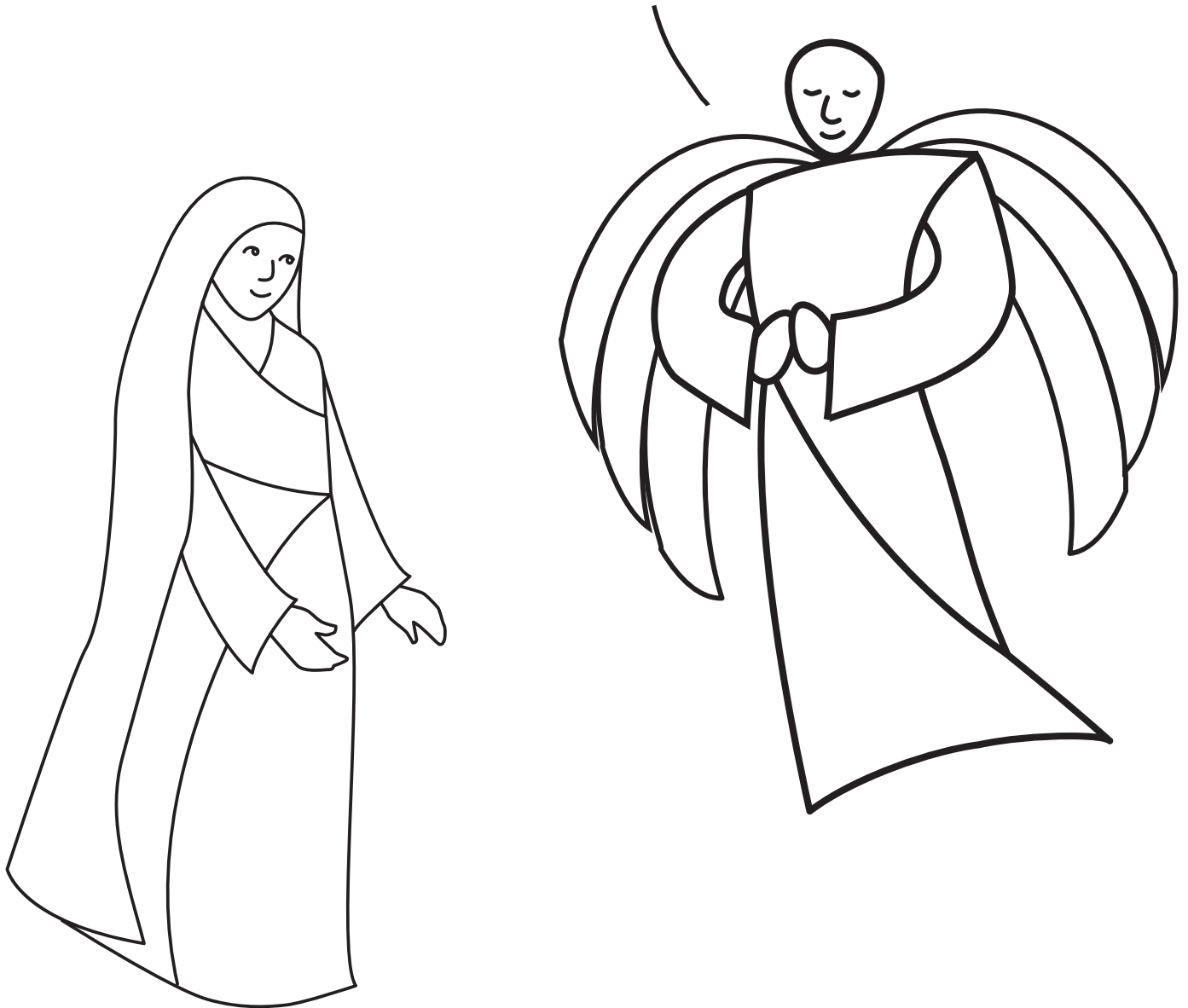
You and Elizabeth will have

Glory to God



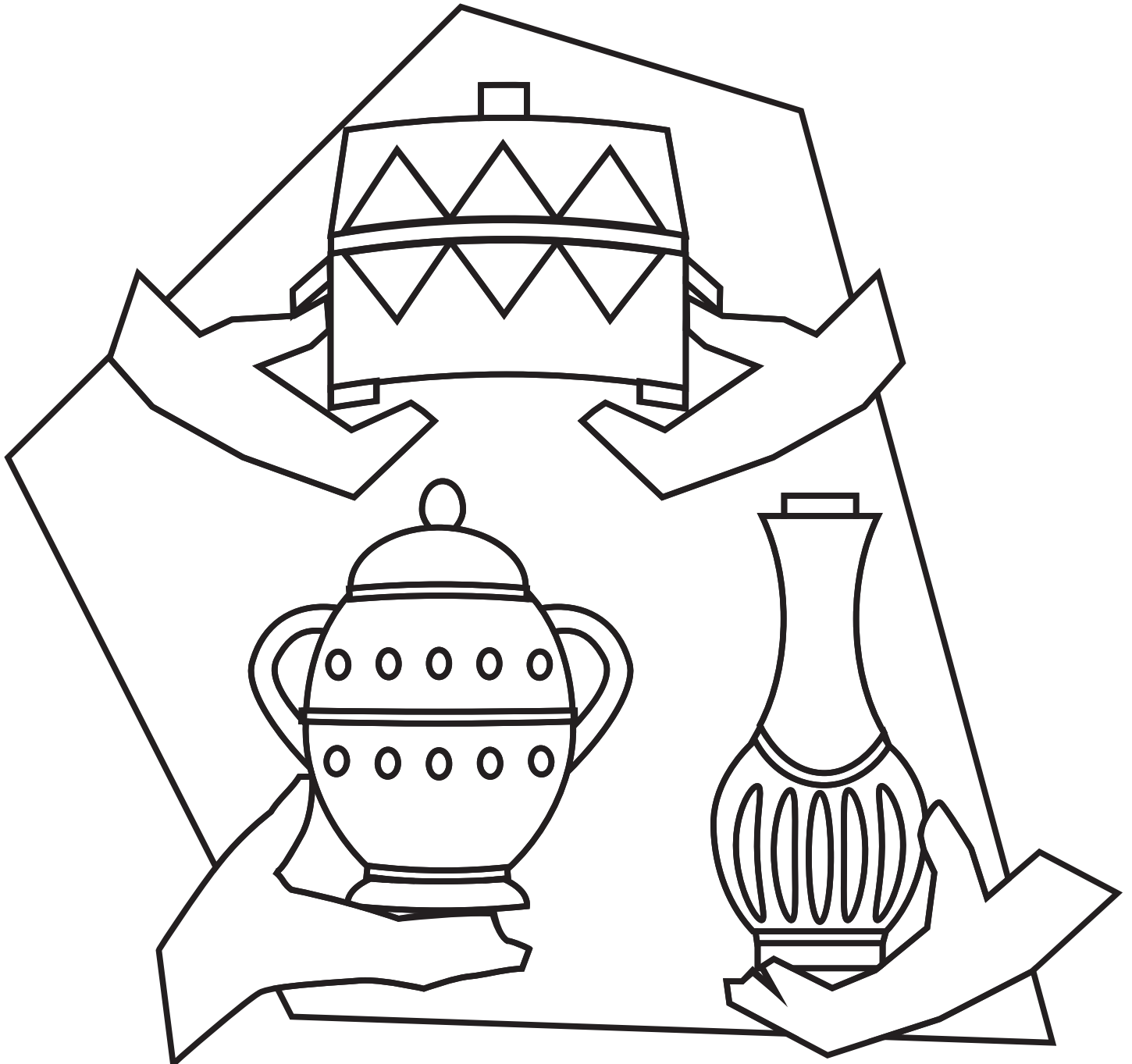
Far away, Magi from the East saw a bright star rising in the sky. They followed the star until it stopped over the spot where Jesus was.
